### Housing Rehabilitation

- Owner Occupied
  - Health & Safety Issues will receive Priority Assistance
- Residential Property in Lexington County
- Minor Rehab up to \$45,000, or 49% value of home, in work required whichever is less
  - Roof Replacement
  - Mold Remediation
  - Exterior Repairs
